

Year 4 – Term 3

English

Reading: During this term we will be reading a range of Greek myths, including Theseus and the Minotaur, Pandora's Box and Medusa.

Writing: We will be performing a re-told Greek myth to develop our understanding of the characters and important messages within the myths. We will also create our own mythical characters and will be writing our own Greek myths.

Maths

We will continue to develop our fluency and rapid recall of our times table facts.

We will also learn about factor pairs, and we will begin to understand how we use them. We will multiply and divide by 10 and 100 and look at related multiplication and division facts. We will learn how to multiply and divide a 2-digit and a 3-digit number by a 1-digit number.

Finally, we will be learning about perimeter, measuring in kilometres and metres.

History

Art

We will learn how to use basic greetings, asking someone how they are feeling and how to provide a response to this. We will develop the skill of holding a simple conversation with a partner, asking questions and being able to answer one.
