

Year 4 – Term 5



English

In English this term we will be exploring the author, Michael Morpurgo. We will look at a variety of his books and poems, and use the knowledge gained about him to write a biography about him.

We will be reading his book, **The Butterfly Lion**, and exploring his use of imagery. We will also use our drama skills to explore the characters in this book. We are also going to learn how to write a detailed book review, giving our opinions and writing informative paragraphs.

Maths

This term we will be learning about decimals. We will be introduced to tenths and hundredths as a fraction and decimal. We will also learn to divide a 1-digit and 2-digit number by 10 and 100. We will then learn to partition, compare, order and round decimals. We will continue to practice our timetables to help with our fluency.

History

We will continue to learn more about the Roman's this term. We will explore what life was like in Roman Britain and what comparisons can be made between the Romans and the Ancient Greeks.

Science

In Science this term we will be learning about the digestive system. We will explore what the digestive system is and its parts and process. We will also learn about the different shapes of teeth and tooth decay. Finally, we will consider what a food chain is and how one can be constructed.

Art

This Term will be practicing still life. We will explore the work of Cezanne and other contemporary and traditional still life artists. We will explore shades and tint. We will also use paint to sketch from observation.

PSHE

This term, we will be learning about relationships. We will explore jealousy and identify why someone is special to us. How we feel about people that we no longer see. We will recognise how friendships change and how we can manage fall outs with friends. We will also discuss boyfriend and girlfriend relationships.

Computing and RE

French

Our topic in French this term is "In the classroom". We will learn to describe what we do and do not have in our pencil case. We will also learn to respond to simple classroom demands.
