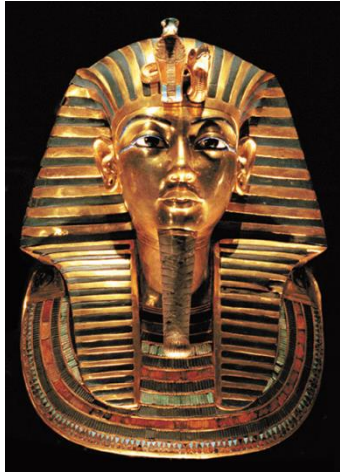


Who were the Ancient Egyptians? Year 3 – Spring Term 2



Topic Overview

This term in Year 3, we will have a focus on history and will be studying the Ancient Egyptians. We will learn about this amazing civilisation and will link our history learning with our art too.

English

For our Reading and Writing lessons this term, we will be focusing on a chapter book called "Iron Man" by Andy Shepherd. In our writing journey, we will look at writing our own newspaper reports and ensuring that we can correctly punctuate our writing for speech.

Maths

In Maths this term we shall be learning how to calculate the perimeter of shapes, compare and order fractions, calculate equivalent fractions and identify the mass and capacity of objects. We shall learn how to use weighing scales and measuring equipment such as jugs and beakers.

Science

In Science, our topic this term is **Forces and Magnets**, the children will observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.

D.T.

In D.T. this term we are focusing on textiles. We are going to create an 'Egyptian Collar' using felt and ribbon. We will be practising our sewing skills and learning the new technique of cross-stitch and applique.

Computing

For this term in Computing we shall be learning about Stop frame animation. This will teach children how to recognise how text and images communicate information.

French

In French, children will be able to recognise, remember and spell **10 action verbs**.

Geography

To be taught next term.

History

This term the children will learn about the Ancient Egyptians and study what life was like for them. We will also discuss their many achievements.

Music

In Music lessons this year, the children will be learning to play the Ukulele, during lessons provided by the Oxfordshire music service.

PSHCE

In PSHE the children will be learning about Healthy Me through Jigsaw Puzzle Piece 4. Being fit, healthy and safe.

P.E.

In our outdoor PE this term we shall be developing our outdoor and adventurous skills and in our indoor PE, Health and Fitness.

R.E.

In RE this term we shall be focusing upon Christianity and examining the question 'What is good about Good Friday?'
