

Year 3 - Summer Term 2

Why do rivers matter?



This term in Year 3, we will have a focus on why rivers matter. Children will study the physical features of a river and its processes. Using this knowledge, the children learn how humans use rivers and how they have historically and still play a crucial role in settlement location.

English

In reading and writing lessons, children will be focusing on 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl, continuing to explore narrative writing from last term and writing their own narratives. After this, children will be using the Geography skills they have learnt this term to write a non-chronological report on Rivers.

Maths

In maths this term we shall be learning about Time: Tell the time to the minute, read time on a digital clock, using Am and PM Years, months and days, days and hours, hours and minutes start and end times, hours and minutes duration. Also Shape: Right angles, compare angles, measure and draw accurately, draw polygons, recognise 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

In Science, our topic this term is **Plants**, the children will learn about how water is transported in a plant.

Art and D.T

In Art this term we will be learning about the artist JMW Turner and exploring his use of watercolour paints. We will be creating our own watercolour painting of the Folly.

Computing

This term in computing we shall learn how to program Sprites to move around a maze successfully using Scratch and Scratch Jr.

French

In French, children will be able to recognise and spell **10 ice cream flavours**.

Geography

In Geography this term, we will be learning about rivers of the world and comparing and contrasting the River Nile and the River Thames.

History

We will be focusing on Geography this term.

Music

Children will continue Ukulele lessons and will have the opportunity to perform in a Summer Concert to show all the skills they have learnt this year.

PSHCE

The children will be learning about Chaning Me (How babies grow, babies, outside body changes, inside body changes, family stereotypes and looking ahead).
