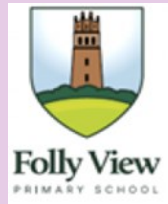

Congratulations!

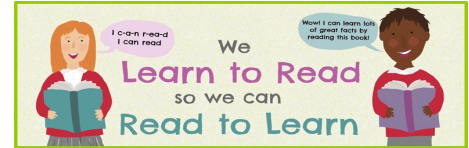
Well done to all the children who took part and completed the Summer Reading Challenge over the summer.

MAKE TIME, MISSION

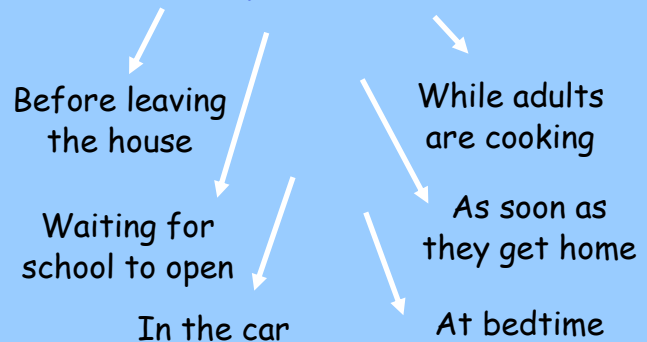


At Folly View we want to support all families to find time each day to pause and pick up a book.

but families tell us it is so hard to find time—so when can we fit it in?

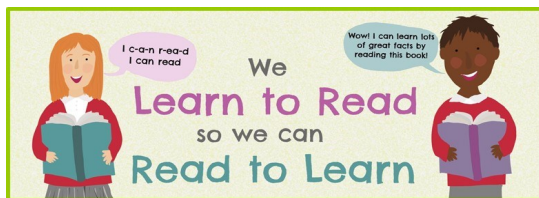
Some families read...

HAVE YOU HEARD ABOUT BOOKVENT?

- * All children have been invited to select a favourite book at home and bring it to school wrapped up for Christmas!
- * Each day in December, we will open a book in class and find out who brought the book and what they love about it.
- * We will share the book with the class and return the book to take back home.
- * Staff are looking forward to taking part too, and enjoy this fun way of sharing books before Christmas.



Supporting your child to read is the single most important thing you can do to assist their schooling!



Three is the magic number!



Help your child to practise the phonics they have been learning in school and develop reading with their Read Write Inc book. It is closely matched to the sounds they are learning in school. Read this book **three times a week** as shown below.

First read

Work together on **accuracy** of old and new sounds that have been taught.

Look out for tricky **RED WORDS**.

Talk about the meanings of new words.

Share a first read through and offer loads of praise.

Second read

Read words with more speed as you remember them from read 1.

Tackle **RED WORDS** with more confidence and speed.

Share a second read with greater **fluency**

Give loads of praise.

Third read

Begin to use knowledge of the book for voices or simple expression.

Confidently read **RED WORDS**.

Answer **comprehension** question on the events, characters, feelings etc.

Read through with confidence and enjoy your well-deserved praise.

Did you know?

Many people stop listening to their child read once they begin chapter books! This can greatly harm their reading development as understanding plot, vocabulary and characterisation can become too difficult without your support.

Keep reading with your child and commenting in their reading diary.
