World Book Day 2024!

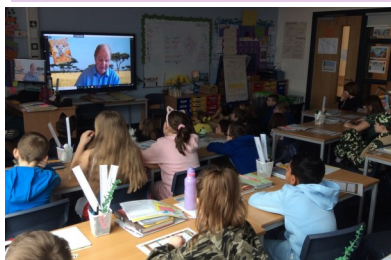
What an amazing day we had at Folly View!



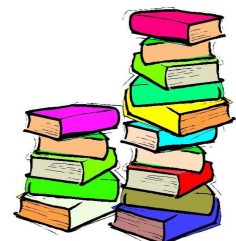
Here are some of the classes sharing their activities and costumes.



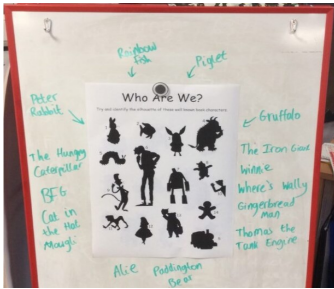
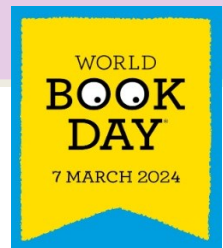
Year 4 tuned into an online webinar with Micheal Morpurgo!



He answered one of their questions and we loved it!



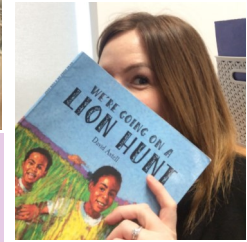
World Book Day 2024!



We played 'Guess The Character from their silhouette.



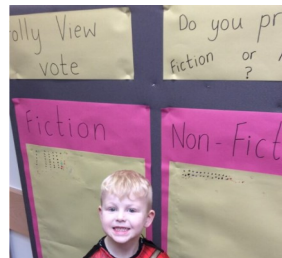
Identify the staff caught reading



We watched and listened to The Colour Monster story



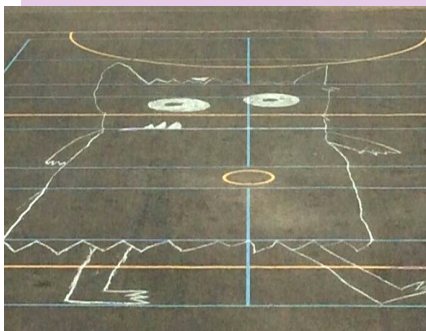
We loved the pop up online version!

Three is the magic number!



Help your child to practise the phonics they have been learning in school and develop reading with their Read Write Inc book. It is closely matched to the sounds they are learning in school. Read this book **three times a week** as shown below.

First read

Work together on **accuracy** of old and new sounds that have been taught.

Look out for tricky **RED WORDS**.

Talk about the meanings of new words.

Share a first read through and offer loads of praise.

Second read

Read words with more speed as you remember them from read 1.

Tackle **RED WORDS** with more confidence and speed.

Share a second read with greater **fluency**

Give loads of praise.

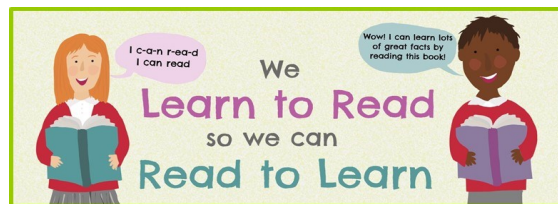
Third read

Begin to use knowledge of the book for voices or simple expression.

Confidently read **RED WORDS**.

Answer **comprehension** question on the events, characters, feelings etc.

Read through with confidence and enjoy your well-deserved praise.



Remember: Supporting your child to read is the single most important thing you can do to assist their schooling!

He lived in a caravan growing up. Reading, writing and drawing were very important to him.

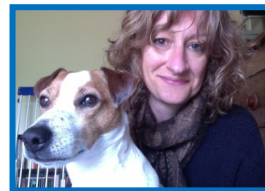


His series of 'Big Bright Feelings' picture books have won many awards and have been translated into over 21 languages
