Cherry Class Staffing

As you know, current employment guidance for COVID 19 dictates that women in their third trimester of pregnancy, should work without remotely. Therefore, from Monday 1st November, Miss McAleer will be working from home for the remainder of her pregnancy.

We are delighted to let you know that we have appointed Miss Charlotte Watson as teacher for Cherry Class from after half term. During term 2, Miss Watson will be working in school, in continual communication with Miss McAleer, who will continue to be responsible for planning the curriculum for Cherry Class.
