This event is intended to be a fun way to submit and celebrate your children's art and also to enjoy art produced by other children.

*'Now in its third year, the Young Artists' Summer Show is a free, open submission exhibition for students aged 5 - 19 studying in the UK and British schools overseas. **Artworks are judged by artists and arts professionals with selected artworks displayed online and on-site at the Royal Academy of Arts.'***

All you need to do is create (or select from artwork already produced), up to three pieces of work your child is particularly proud of. This can then be photographed / scanned in and sent to your child's teacher via the class email. You will also need to complete and return the permission form, read through the guidance information and include a short description/ explanation of the art work.

We hope you will join us in this fantastic opportunity and we look forward to beginning to receive some super art work from your children soon. The closing date to submit your work to your child's teacher will be Sunday 18th April 2021.
