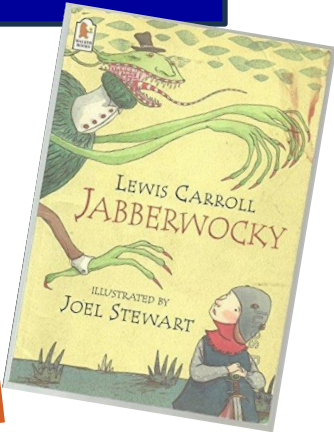
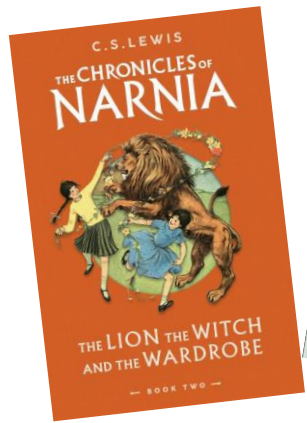


Year 4 – Term 6



English

This term, in reading, we will be exploring 'The Chronicles of Narnia' by C.S. Lewis. We will continue to expand our understanding of new vocabulary, inferencing, predictions, explaining, retrieval, and summarising.

During the first 4 weeks of term, we will write a newspaper report based on the short film, The Dream Giver.

Next, we will study the poem Jabberwocky by Lewis Carroll.

Maths

This term we will begin by learning about money. We will convert between pounds and pence, compare amounts and estimate. Next, we will explore time, looking at analogue and digital time. Then we will expand our understanding of shape, symmetry, charts, and graphs. We will continue to practice our timetables to help with our fluency.

Geography

The key question is, "Is our twinned town a world away from ours?" We will take a closer look at Faringdon's twinned town Le Mele-Sur-Sathe in Normandy, France. We will explore and make comparisons.

Science

In Science this term we will be learning about living things and their habitats. We begin by re-visiting the seven life processes and sorting animals into groups. We will build on our knowledge by identifying vertebrates and invertebrates. We will also look at using classification keys.

DT

This term we will be exploring simple circuits and switches. We will use our learning from science - electricity - to design and make a torch. We will evaluate our final product.



PSHE

This term the theme is 'Changing Me.' We will look at what makes us unique, what makes us, us. We will learn about some of the changes we go through as we get older. We will learn about girls and puberty, and ways we learn to accept changes that happen.

Computing and RE

In computing, we will explore repetition in games using Scratch.

In RE we will answer the question: How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks?

French

Our topic in French this term is "At the café/tearoom/restaurant'. We will learn how to make a simple order by learning some basic food and drinks in French.

PE

Rounders and Athletics in preparation for Sports Day.

Music

This term we will be taking part in the Royal Opera House Create Day. For this, we will be learning a song that we will perform on the day.
